IT IS ORDERED THAT:

Page Limits (Joint Expert Statements)

1. In accordance with paragraph 22 of the Tribunal's Order made 4 August 2025, by **4pm** on **30 June 2026** the parties are to file joint expert statements setting out matters agreed and not agreed between the parties' experts in each respective field as follows:
 - 1.1 A joint expert statement in respect of Economics (market definition, dominance, exclusionary abuse, incidence / pass-on and quantum), limited to **50 pages**, excluding annexes (which shall be confined to supporting material and shall not contain substantive opinion);
 - 1.2 A joint expert statement in respect of Economics (exploitative abuse and quantum), limited to **40 pages**, excluding annexes (which shall be confined to supporting material and shall not contain substantive opinion);
 - 1.3 A joint expert statement in respect of Forensic Accounting, limited to **25 pages**, excluding annexes (which shall be confined to supporting material and shall not contain substantive opinion);
 - 1.4 A joint expert statement in respect of Payments, limited to **20 pages**, excluding annexes (which shall be confined to supporting material and shall not contain substantive opinion); and
 - 1.5 A joint expert statement in respect of Security, limited to **20 pages**, excluding annexes (which shall be confined to supporting material and shall not contain substantive opinion).
2. Costs in the case.
3. There be liberty to apply.
